- 1960 - Second International Congress in Freudenstadt, Germany.
- 1962 - Third International Congress in Nice, France.
- 1965 - First Congress of the International Federation of Manual Medicine in London, England, September 25-29, attended by 279 physicians from 19 countries. The North American Academy of Manipulative Medicine was formed by American physicians attending that conference. Membership is open to all who possess an M.D. degree, or its equivalent in the case of graduates from foreign medical schools.
